This letter is in reference to your demonstration of the "Tool Room Accounting and Control System (TRACS)" during the Quarterly Expedited Modernization Initiative Procedure Demonstrations at Selfridge Air National Guard Base, 19-21 October 2009. The Expedited Modernization Initiative Procedure (EMIP) demonstration educated both observers and decision makers on potential capabilities and allows us to provide the following feedback.

Your demonstration was observed by a technical team composed of engineers, logisticians, user representatives, test representatives, and subject matter experts. A technology of the type of war fighting capability (Distribution Mission Enhancements) you demonstrated was viewed as having a medium military utility potential, and scored medium in military merit. Based on our overall priorities, a technology of this type of capability may be an approach. We may forward your idea to: Army Sustainment Command; Product Manager Sets, Kits, and Outfits. EMIP is an on-going process, and you may be asked more questions by someone from these offices or others involved in this process.


